- Contact SWAC (Bexley) to get involved with community litter picks and visit the sustainable café.

- Organise your own litter pick on the way to school (always ask an adult first)
- Write a letter to your local MP or the Prime Minister to share ideas how to improve recycling and how they can help
- Make a poster and display it to encourage people to reduce, reuse, recycle
- Reduce the amount of single use plastic you use
