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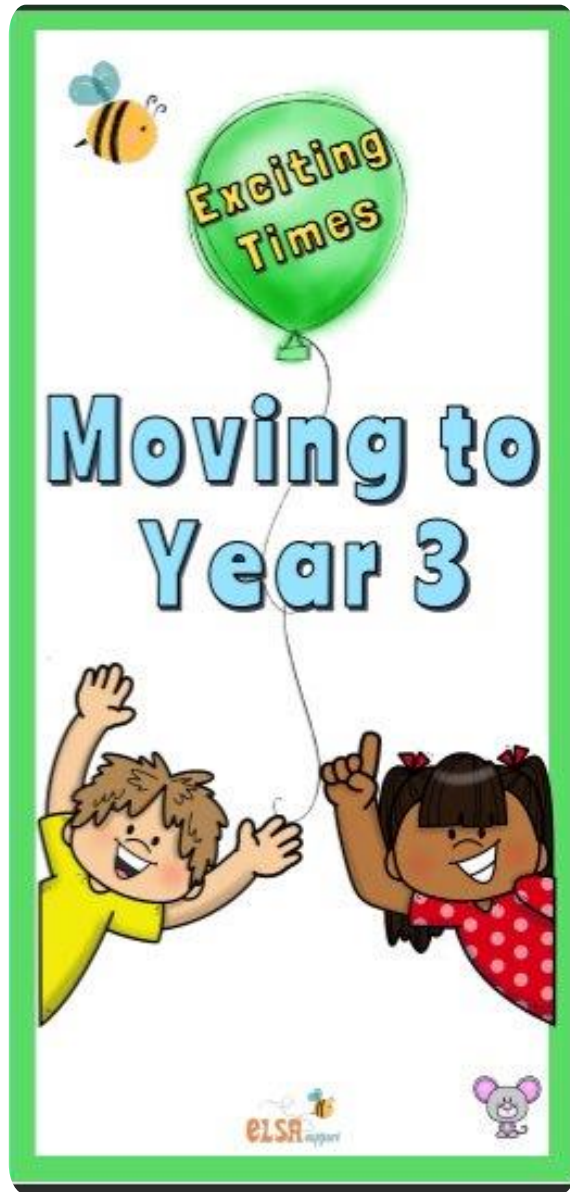


How to support your child's transition

Wellbeing

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Moving from Y2 to Y3 can be an exciting time for some children, but others may take a bit longer to find their feet, but THAT'S OK!



Feelings

I might have lots of feelings about moving to year 3. That's ok! Everyone has feelings when things change. I might feel sad. I might feel worried. I might feel excited. I might have a mix of lots of feelings.



It's Ok to have mixed feelings

What can I do to support my child?

- ▶ Talk to your child about the upcoming transition
- ▶ If they're feeling worried or anxious validate how they're feeling, remind them it's okay to feel anxious, scared, or excited about the change.
- ▶ Take time out to sit and talk through what it is that's worrying them.
- ▶ Share experiences of times you felt worried or anxious and what helped you



Focus on the positives - remind them of the exciting times ahead
