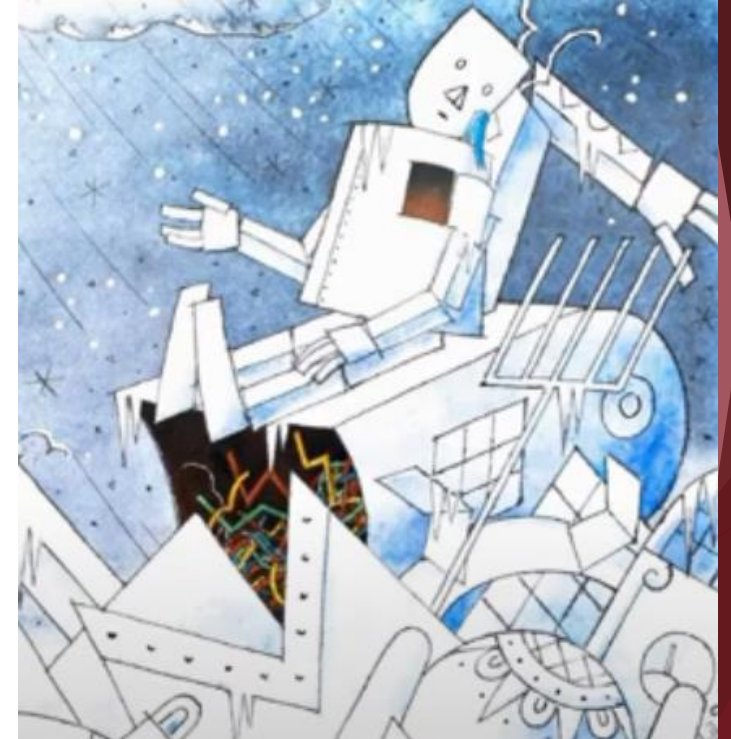

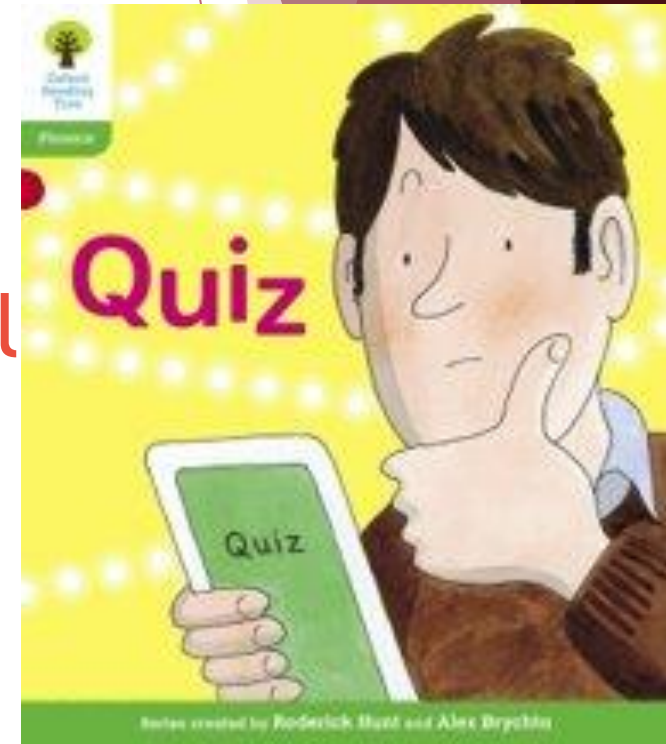

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# What is a fact family?

The number sentences that use the same numbers to say the same calculation in different ways.

$4 + 1 = 5$	
$1 + 4 = 5$	
$5 - 1 = 4$	
$5 - 4 = 1$
